INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

To, The Members, Nowgong Sports Association R.K.B. Road Nagaon, Assam

Opinion

We have audited the financial statements of **NOWGONG SPORTS ASSOCIATION**, which comprise the balance sheet as at March 31, 2024, Income & Expenditure Account and Receipt and Payments Account the year then ended, and notes to the financial statements, including a summary of significant accounting policies.

In our opinion, the accompanying financial statements give a true and fair view of the financial position of the entity as at March 31, 2024, and of its financial performance for the year then ended in accordance with the Accounting Standards issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI).

Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with Standards on Auditing (SAs). Our responsibilities under those Standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements section of our report. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.

Responsibilities of Management and Those Charged with Governance for the Financial Statements

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in accordance with the aforesaid Accounting Standards, and for such internal control as management determines is necessary to enable the preparation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the financial statements, management is responsible for assessing the entity's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless management either intends to liquidate the entity or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.

Those charged with governance are responsible for overseeing the entity's financial reporting process.

Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements as a whole are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that accordance our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with SAs will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of these financial statements.

 override of internal control.

 procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an
 opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control.

SCHEDULE 'S' OF NOTES ON ACCOUNTS AND SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES ATTACHED TO AND FORMING PART OF BALANCE SHEET AS AT 31ST MARCH 2024

1. FIXED ASSETS:-

To account fixed assets at cost of acquisition inclusive of inward freight, duties, taxes and incidental expenses relating to acquisition. In respect of expansion involving construction, related proportionate expenses form part of the value of assets capitalised. Expenses incurred up to the date of putting the assets in working condition for its intended use are also capitalized with relative assets. Expanses for maintenance and repairs are charged to revenue as incurred.

Contrary to standard accounting practice and Accounting Standard No.10 issued by The Institute of Chartered Accountants of India, fixed assets are stated at written down value without showing the original cost and accumulated depreciation.

2. METHOD OF ACCOUNTING:-

To recognize revenue and to charge against revenue all costs and expenses on cash system of accounting.

3. HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT:-

To charge to revenue all expenses and income relating to training and human development in the year in which it is incurred or earned.

4. CONTINGENT LIABILITIES:-

Not to provide for any contingent liabilities except for cases where provision needs to be made based on expert opinion.

5. DEPRECIATION:-

To calculate depreciation on fixed assets on written down value method and to provide such depreciation irrespective of the period of use for whole year on assets if purchased during the year. Further, no depreciation on an asset is provided in the year in which it is sold / discarded irrespective of the period of its use during the year.

6. GENERAL:-

To maintain and record transaction and to prepare and finalize annual accounts on historical cost basis.
